- Completes work in class on time
- Completes homework on time

- Silver sticker

Green Level Students

Respect

- Uses Manners / follows instructions
- Remains calm
- Talks with respect to self and others including property and personal space

Classroom conduct and homework

- Displays best effort
- Engages in learning
- Completes homework at home and on time

 Plays by the rules using Stop, Walk, Talk, or Big Problem, Small Problem no Problem

Blue Level Students

Respect

- Swearing/ Back-chat /Lying/ cheating
- Not following teacher / supervisor's instructions
- Uniform non-compliance (without a note)

Physical conduct, bullying or cyber bullying

- Verbal bullying, teasing; physical or mental
- Not respecting other people's personal space/ throwing objects

Property

Damaging or not returning someone else's property; stealing

Classroom conduct and homework

- Not completing set tasks on time, including homework
- ICT breach

Playground conduct

- Not playing by the rules
- Arguing with other students

Consequences

- Moving levels; rule reminder
- Blue Sticker
- Parent notification; possible withdrawal from play
- Behaviour plan
- Withdrawal from school activities
- Continual breaches will result in negotiation relating to inclusion in extracurricular activities.

Black Level Students

Respect

- Continual defiance not following teacher instructions / back-chat
- Swearing at other students, staff or visitors /ongoing lying
- Repeated or ongoing uniform non-compliance

Physical violence and bullying

- Fighting, including: hitting, punching, kicking, spitting, pushing, tripping and shoving
- Bullying resulting in physical contact with other students, staff or visitors

Property

Stealing other's property/ Wilful damage of property (graffiti and vandalism)

Continual unsafe play

Consequences

- Referral to Office/Principal
- Withdrawal from class activities
- Parent interview
- Behaviour re-entry plan
- Withdrawal from excursion
- Suspension
- Expulsion
